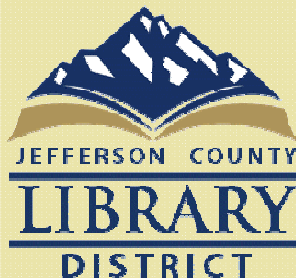

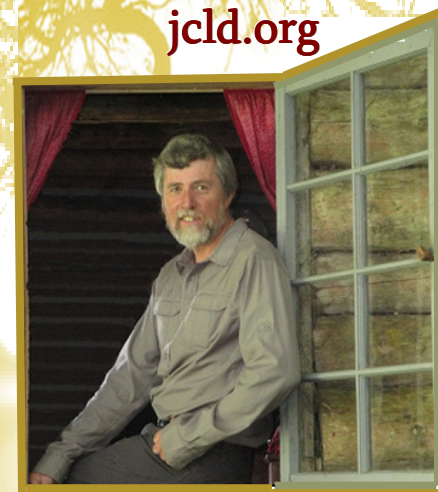

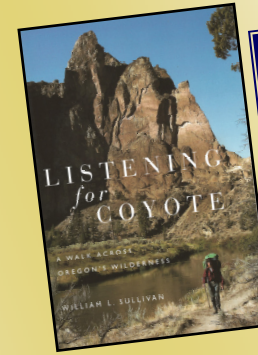
Crooked River Ranch is hosting a full day of activities for the 2013 Jefferson County Community Read on Sunday, April 21. The day starts with a hike along the Crooked River on the Otter Bench Trail led by author Bill Sullivan and our local Forest Service specialists. There will be CRR tours and comfortable places for R & R. Participants must be 16 or over.

While the complete Otter Bench Loop is 7.1 miles, feel free to go any distance you want at any pace you want. For those taking shorter hikes, there will be many other ways to spend a wonderful day at Crooked River Ranch.

**What's the first thing to do?** Register and pay online for the day's events! **Your \$18 fee (non-refundable) includes lunch, transportation, and all of the other opportunities provided by your hosts.** Be sure to print the voucher for your meal. Registration begins on March 25 and closes when 50 participants have signed up or by April 16.

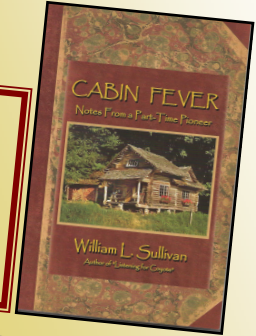
